Logging into Canvas

First time Canvas users:

Once you have registered for courses for the first time, your Canvas account will be automatically generated.

LoLA and Canvas login information is the same:

If you already have your LoLA username and have created a password, your LoLA login information is the same for Canvas! If you change your LoLA password, it changes your Canvas password as well.

Your student email is NOT the same as your LoLA and Canvas accounts.

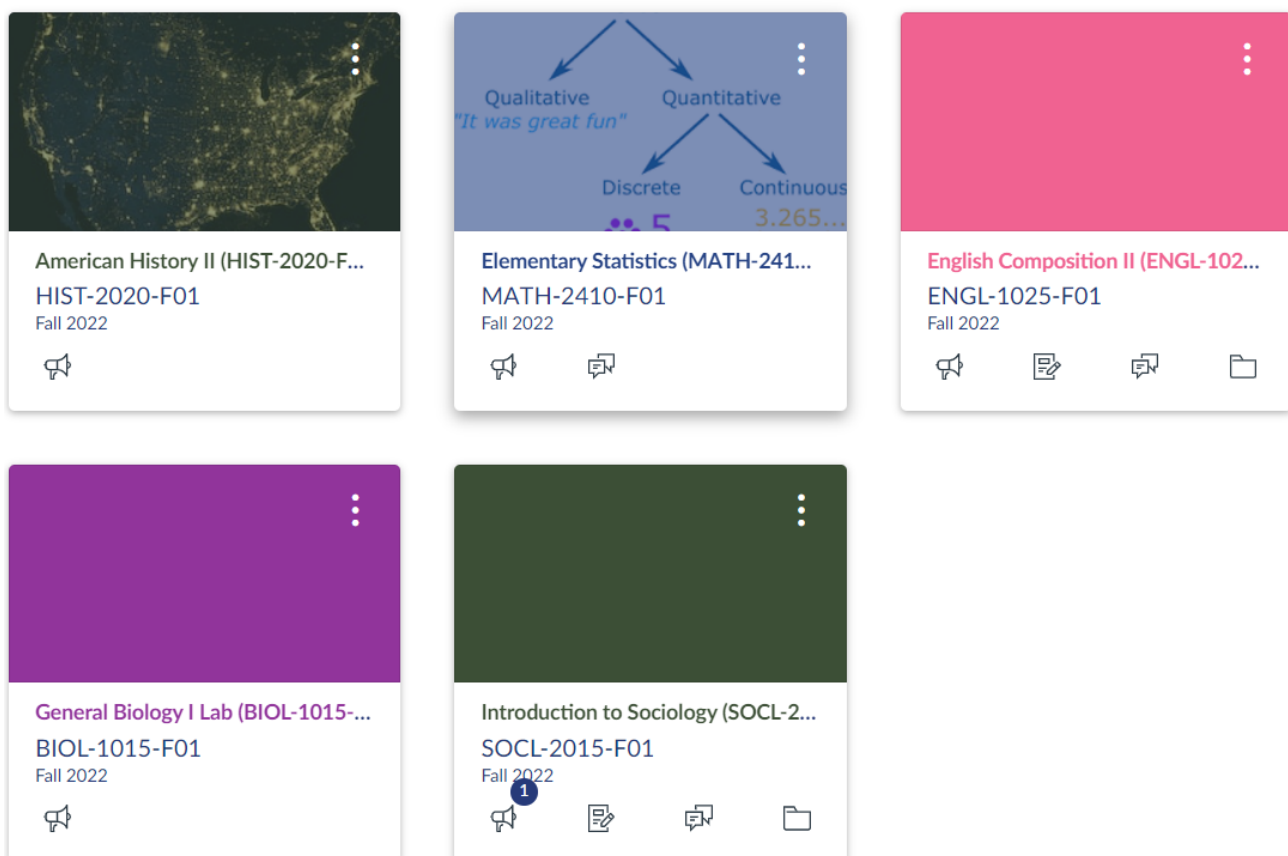
Canvas Dashboard: Seeing your Courses

Course Visibility:

Courses are usually published no later than the first official day of the semester.

For each course you are registered in, a Course Tile will appear on your Dashboard.

Example Dashboard with Course Tiles:

1. Please check your course schedule in LoLA to verify your course enrollment.
2. Please contact the instructor to ask if the course has been published.

Accessing Course Material:

To access your course material, click on the course Tile. This will bring you into the course, and you will be able to see the course material.

To change the Dashboard view, click the three dots on the top right of your Dashboard.

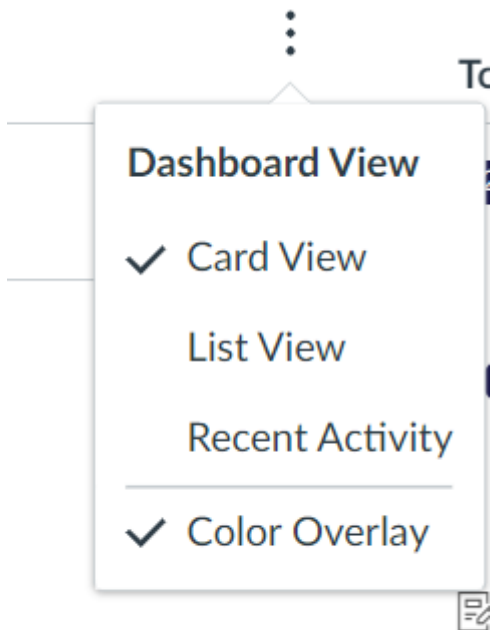


